- Prep, Year 1 & 2, Friday 28th Nov, 10:00am



Discovery is the 'lens of inquiry' across the school this term. The curriculum focus encompasses the learning areas of Design and Technology. Students will be using their creative and critical thinking skills as they work through the design thinking cycle. Across the school we have planned a range of different experiences and are calling for any parent experts in the community who have knowledge and experience to share with our students. Here are some of the planned design briefs and final products the students will be designing and creating.

Prep- Solving problems based on fairytale stories. Year 1 & 2 - Creating a musical instrument as they explore the concept of sound.

Year 3 & 4 - Creating a product made out of wool or wheat.

Year 5 & 6 - Creating products for a Christmas Market.




Production Footage
