Dear Parents/Carers,

What a fabulous start to the school year. A very special welcome to our Prep students and their families. The Prep children began school for the very first time on Monday, and all seemed very excited to be here and have settled in well. The playground has been full of excitement as old friendships have been rekindled.

The start of the new school year can be a challenging time for some children and parents. Dr Judith Lock, author of the parenting book, The Bonsai Child provides her tips on how to support your child as they transition to a new year.

If your child is anxious about starting a new class with unfamiliar people, do listen to them talk about their fears, but normalise them ('A lot of people feel worried about starting something new'), and then talk about their past strengths in facing tricky things and your confidence that they will cope with this challenge.

When they come home from their first day at a new activity, keep your questions broad, 'How was it?' not, 'Did you make a friend today?' or 'Is Sam in your class?' This won't put unnecessary pressure

on them or suggest things in which they should be disappointed.

Exceptional Education

Keep your and your child's expectations realistic. It is highly unlikely that they will form close friendships in the early days of a new school year, particularly in early primary. How often have you started a new job and come home from your first day to announce, 'I made my new best friend today'?

COVID 19 Requirements for Term 1 2021

All Visitors

To support contact tracing, all visitors must sign in at the office and provide their details in accordance with the school's COVID Safe Plan. Face masks must be worn at all times.

Social Distancing

Social distancing between adults will continue. This will apply to staff while working on-site as well as parents at drop off and pick up times. While waiting for children at the end of the day please use the appropriate markings indicating where adults can stand, this will reduce congestion.

Use of Face Masks

Face masks are not required outdoors except where physical distancing of 1.5 metres cannot be maintained. Please consider this when you drop off and pick up your children.

Morning Drop Off

Where possible one adult is to continue to drop off children no earlier than 8:40 am. Please continue to bring your child/ren through the double gates near the church on Nicholson Street or Miller Street, you are now able to enter the Middle Yard in the mornings, please don't stay for a period longer than 15 minutes and remember to use the appropriate physical distancing markings. When exiting the school grounds please use the small gate on Nicholson or Miller Street as you have done so last year. If children arrive after 9.00am they are to enter the school building via the office and Parents/Carers must sign each child in via the school passtab.

Afternoon Pick Up

There are markings around the perimeter of the Northern and Middle Yards as well as through the centre of the Middle Yard that are spaced at 1.5 metre intervals and we ask that Parents/Carers continue to use these while waiting. The direction of traffic will be in reverse to that in the mornings with Parent/Carer entry through the small gates and families exiting through the double gates on Nicholson Street and Miller Street.

Parent/Carer Volunteers

Parent/Carer Volunteers can resume this term however face masks must be worn while volunteering indoors and physical distancing regulations must be adhered to. All attendance must be registered through the office.

Assemblies

Face-to-face year level indoor assemblies will occur on Wednesdays, only Parents/Carers of the presenting class will be able to attend due to density regulations. Depending on numbers, seating may be arranged outside as we must adhere to the indoor density limit of one person per two square metres. Parents/Carers attending must sign in at the office and provide their details in accordance with the school's COVID Safe Plan.

Sharing of Food

Sharing of food is not permitted at this time so unfortunately children will not be able to bring in cupcakes for birthday celebrations, lolly bags are also not permitted during this time.

Unwell Students

If your child is unwell and is exhibiting symptoms indicative of COVID 19 (sore throat, runny nose, fever, cough) we strongly encourage you to keep your child home and seek medical advice.

Students with Underlying Medical Conditions (such as hay fever or asthma)

If your child has persistent symptoms due to an underlying condition such as hay fever or asthma, your child should still be tested for coronavirus (COVID-19) if they develop symptoms that are different to or worse than their usual symptoms.

Parents/Carers should also consider obtaining a medical certificate from the child's treating GP to confirm that it is safe for them to attend school with persistent symptoms that may overlap with some of the symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) such as cough or runny nose.

Children with a negative coronavirus (COVID-19) test whose symptoms have completely resolved do not need a medical certificate to return to the school.
