Our Rights

- 1. I have the right to feel safe at all times.
- 2. I have the right to say 'no' to anything that I believe will harm my physical or mental wellbeing.
- 3. I have the right to ask a trusted adult for help with any problem, including problems that happen at school, home or anywhere else in the community.
- 4. I have the right to choose to spend my time with people that make me feel safe and comfortable.
- 5. I have the right to point out unsafe behaviours that others may be doing.
- 6. I have the right to be treated with respect and fairness, including how I am spoken to.
- 7. I have the right to choose and voice my thoughts, opinions and religion and I must respect the same in others.
- 8. I have the right to stand up for myself and others when there is poor behaviour or bullying.
- 9. I have the right to make mistakes and learn from them.
- 10. I have the right to 'tell on' someone if they are hurting me or making me upset, even if that person is an adult.
- 11. I have the right to SAY NO to spending time with people who make me feel uncomfortable or unsafe.
- 12. I have the right to make my own decisions.
- 13. I have the right to feel included and to feel as though I belong to a family, school and a community.
- 14. I have the right to be listened to.
- 15. I have the right to express my opinion and my feelings.
