#### Communication Processes

We pride ourselves in providing up to date and timely information to parents so they can be as organised as possible to support their children. Below is a list of some of the communication processes here at OLHC. Please ensure you are familiar and have access to these documents/platforms to stay as up to date as possible.

**School Newsletter** - Our school newsletter is published fortnightly on a Friday Week 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9. This is emailed directly to you and is also uploaded to our school website each fortnight. The newsletter contains important dates and reminders for the term.

**Termly Curriculum Overviews** - At the beginning of each term parents will receive an overview of what the focus of learning is in core curriculum subjects and our specialist programs. These will be emailed directly to you and can also be found on our school website.

**Parent Handbook** - Is an extensive document that provides parents with some insights and processes at our school. It is organised in an easy format and can be found on our school website under Parent Participation.

**Teacher Email** - All staff email addresses can be found on our website, please feel free to contact your child/ren's class teacher if you have any questions or queries, please note teachers will not

respond to emails after 5.30 pm and before 8.00 am each day.



**Updat-ed App** - For those families who are new to the school, and for those who may not be

aware, the school has an app linked to our website account that enables us to push out short announcements that may be of interest or importance to our school community. We encourage you to sign up to this so that you don't miss out on information and events throughout the year. Look for the symbol above in your device's App Store, choose Our Lady Help of Christians School, and follow the rest of the set-up instructions to sign up – signing up is cost free.

#### Learning Conversations (Meet the Teacher)

Learning Conversations (Meet the Teacher) will be held <u>face to face</u> on Wednesday 14th February from 1.30 pm - 8.30 pm. <u>Please note school concludes at 1.00 pm for all students on this day.</u> Please refer to the flyer attached for booking details. Bookings are now open and close on Monday the 12th of February at 4.00pm.

Please note this is a meeting between parents and the class teacher, children are not required to attend this first meeting.



#### **Medical Conditions**

Your child's health and safety is extremely important to us. We therefore need to know about any medical conditions your child has. Please provide the school with a valid Action Plan and medical kit if

required, such as Ventolin, spacer and Epipen®. The Action Plan must be completed in consultation with your family doctor and should be returned as soon as possible. Your child's Action Plan will need to be reviewed annually in order for attendance at school excursions and camps.

If your child requires medication during school hours, please provide our administration staff with the medication and complete the Medication Form indicating permission to administer the medication, in its original packaging with clear instructions for example dosage, frequency etc. Medical Forms are located at the office.

#### Managing Teacher Shortages

As most of you would have heard through the media, the reality of teacher shortages in schools is real. Victoria's extreme teacher shortage has reached a crisis point as students return to the classroom, with more than 900 positions in government schools still advertised. We are fortunate to have filled our teaching positions for the 2024 school year in order to successfully continue to offer all programs to our students. From time to time, teachers however will be absent from school for personal reasons, long service leave, or professional learning opportunities. We follow the two steps outlined below in order to manage teacher absences:

Step 1: Reach out to our casual relieving teacher (CRT) network.

Step 2: Explore internal management options, such as using our school leadership team if all options have been exhausted.

Thank you for your ongoing support and cooperation as we continue to provide stability for our students during this time.

Concessional Fee Policy

We are pleased to announce the continuation of the Concessional Fee Policy to assist eligible families in accessing a Catholic primary education for their child/ren.

The Concessional Fee is an amount determined by Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic Schools (MACS) and covers the School Fee, Building Fee and Curriculum Levy (excluding Camp). Other Levies, such as Camp, are not covered and will be charged in addition to the Concessional Fee. Please note that the Concessional Fee already factors in any eligible CSEF discount (as discussed above) and

does not result in a further reduction of the Concessional Fee.

To access the Concessional Fee, eligible families must also enter into an automated payment plan, either through CentrePay or Direct Debit.




