MORNING CHANGES

Now that we have been back at school for some weeks and most children are comfortable saying goodbye to parents at the gates, we are making two adjustments to what happens in the mornings.

We ask that parents continue to say goodbye at the gates at the end of both paths into the Middle Yard but instead of the children going straight into class, we are asking them to place their bags on lines as in the past and to play quietly before the bell goes for them to line up to come into class. There will be no announcements at the start of the day, but teachers will be collecting children from the line promptly at 8:55 am so please ensure that you are on time.

Those children who do arrive late will again need to be signed in using the Pass Tab iPad in the Front Office. The expectation will be that, in the case of several families running late, only one family will be allowed into the office at any time with others to remain social distanced outside to await their turn.

FAREWELL TO FR JOEL

The exception to no announcements will be on Friday morning next week when we will briefly hold the children on lines to formally farewell Fr Joel before he takes up his appointment in Heidelberg. Our captains will make a presentation on behalf of the school community to thank him for his time in our school community and to acknowledge his leadership since May 2019.

Fr Joel has been the Administrator of the Parish of Brunswick and Brunswick East for just over twelve months and, in that time, has been eager to share his faith in God with staff and children. Fr Joel was also committed to finding the right candidate for the principalship of our school and leaves the school in the good hands of Maree McIntosh, and the parish in the good hands of both Monsignor Greg Bennet and Fr Greg Bourke.

SCHOOL REPORTING FOR SEMESTER ONE

A reminder that reports this half year will look different from usual. Following the advice of the Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority (VCAA), Victorian Department of Education and Training, and Catholic Education Commission of Victoria Ltd (CECV), this report will provide:

- a description of the Victorian Curriculum subjects of Literacy and Numeracy taught in Semester 1, and the Religious Education content for this semester.
- a succinct descriptive assessment of student learning in the above areas.
- a comment on how your child has adjusted to the remote and flexible learning environment and transition back to school.

Early next semester, your child and their teacher will engage in conversations around learning goals for the remainder of the year and these will be sent home together with a self-reflection completed by each child.

Parent Teacher meetings to discuss learning progress have been rescheduled to take place in October, and the end of year report in December will provide a more comprehensive view of the year's learning across all usual curriculum areas.


